## Los Alamitos Trunk Sewer Project



### Location: Northbound Los Alamitos Blvd.

OC San is conducting sewer line cleaning and manhole rehabilitation on southbound Los Alamitos Blvd./Seal Beach Blvd. from Katella Avenue to Bradbury Road, as shown on the map. The activity consists of removing calcium buildup at various pipe joints at night when sewer flows are lower. The manhole repair is necessary to allow future access to the pipe for cleaning and maintenance. The activity may require lane reductions and excavations.

#### **Timeline**


Mid-August 2022 – October 2022\*

Line cleaning: Sunday – Thursday, 8 p.m. – 6 a.m. Manhole work: Monday – Friday, 8:30 a.m. – 6 p.m. (see map & legend for specific locations)
